In 2010 JSTOR expanded its vast collection of archival content to include the most recent issues of academic journals. The Current Scholarship Program (CSP) provides access to more than 260 high-quality current titles from 44 leading publishers, linking current journals with archival content on JSTOR's trusted platform. Through CSP, publishers may distribute current journals and increase visibility, libraries may further consolidate holdings and save money, and scholars may access the full runs—archival and current issues—of up to 269 academic journals on an integrated, powerful, convenient, affordable digital platform.

Institutions may place orders directly from JSTOR or via subscription agents, and are able to maintain a single license and point of purchase across many publishers and titles. To aid institutions' evaluation processes, our free Holdings Comparison Service will compare your holdings to the titles in the Current Scholarship Program.
